International Common Standards for Gendai Reiki Masters Gendai Reiki Healing Association

Revised on and effective as of September 1, 2020

- 1. The International Common Standards for Gendai Reiki Masters (hereinafter the Common Standards) have been set to maintain good morals, dignity, and ethics set forth by Gendai Reiki Healing Association represented by Hiroshi Doi (hereinafter GRHA).
- 2. All Gendai Reiki Masters must abide by the regulations listed below.
 - The Gendai Reiki Official Manuals
 - (1) The Gendai Reiki Official Manuals are available in Japanese, English, and Spanish. The Official Manuals are identical, and there is the National Seals of Japan on the covers to show that Reiki originated in Japan.
 - (2) *Gendai Reiki Essentials Japanese* were published in 2000 as the standard manuals. In April 2012, the Gendai Reiki Official Japanese Manuals were published after a number of revisions; therefore, all the older manuals had been discontinued. Gendai Reiki Masters must use the latest Official Manuals listed on the GRHA official website.
 - (3) All Gendai Reiki Masters must purchase the Official Manuals from authorized distributors or GRHA.
 - (4) The Official English and Spanish Manuals have been revised in 2020. The Masters who are using the older manuals must switch to the latest Official Manuals immediately. Masters who live in a country where there is no authorized distributor may purchase the previous official manual in a PDF digital file from GRHA. Once an authorized distributor opens near you, you must purchase the latest official manuals from them. Masters who continue using the previous manuals even after a distributor has opened must not use the name "Gendai Reiki Ho", "Gendai Reiki", "現代霊気", "現代霊気法", "現代レイキ", and "現代レイキ 法".
 - (5) The Official Manuals must only be used at the Gendai Reiki Ho seminars by Gendai Reiki masters who teach Gendai Reiki Ho correctly. GRHA shall stop providing the official manuals to masters who violate the Common Standards.
 - (6) To order your official manuals from your nearest distributor or GRHA, you must submit your Gendai Reiki master certificates, written lineage, and Promissory Note with your signature. Each official manual comes with a unique serial number. It is the number to identify the purchasing master and to prevent an illegal copy.
 - (7) Do not give, show, or disclose the Official Manuals publicly.
 - (8) Do not add on, change, and/or remove anything from the Official Manuals in any way. Making a photocopy of the Official Manuals is strictly prohibited.
 - (9) Introduction and Level I build an important foundation of Gendai Reiki Ho for beginners. These two Official Manuals must be purchased and taught together for a better understanding of Gendai Reiki Ho.
 - (10) Translation of the official manuals:
 - > Unauthorized translation of the Official Manuals is strictly prohibited.
 - GRHA sets qualification standards for a translator and proofreader. If you are interested in translating the Official Manuals into your language, please contact the GRHA.

- (11) Shipment of the Official Manuals may take up to three to four weeks, depending on a location. It is recommended to keep a few copies on hand in case of an urgent seminar.
- Gendai Reiki Ho Seminars
 - (1) Do not change the Gendai Reiki Ho Attunement methods. Each Gendai Reiki Ho Attunement contains philosophy and conscious vibrations of Mikao Usui Sensei. Adding any other thoughts, philosophy, and symbols from different types of Reiki result in losing the purity of the energy. Pay special attention to the first attunement in Level I since it will build an important foundation for all the attunements in the advanced levels.
 - (2) The Gendai Reiki Ho attunement and Reiju methods must be taught only to your Level IV students with all the necessary information written in the Level IV official manual during a face-to-face seminar.
 - (3) The attunements must be given face-to-face. In the Japanese Original Usui Reiki System, Reiki begins with a hand-placement treatment with a goal of reaching Anshin Ritsumei through spiritual enhancement. Distant attunement does not belong to Mikao Usui Sensei's philosophy. We must pass down the pure Reiki energy with Usui Sensei's philosophy correctly; therefore, Gendai Reiki Ho does not permit distant attunements. Masters who have received distant attunement are not considered Gendai Reiki masters.
 - (4) The Gendai Reiki Ho Symbols must not be disclosed or shown to those who have not attained the appropriate levels.
 - (5) A Gendai Reiki Master must give a certificate and a correct energy lineage in writing to your trainee after your seminar. The certificate must state that Gendai Reiki Ho has been taught to the person. The energy lineage must begin with Mikao Usui Sensei and list all the masters to your trainee correctly.
 - (6) When listing your title as a Gendai Reiki Master, avoid using a confusing title together, such as "Usui Reiki Master." It may lead to a misunderstanding that Gendai Reiki Ho and Japanese Original Usui Reiki Ryoho are different.
- A name of a Gendai Reiki Ho school or a group

A Gendai Reiki master may decide a school or a group name on his/her own responsibility. If a Gendai Reiki master group or an individual chooses to bear the name of a region or country, they must obtain the consent of all Gendai Reiki masters and groups in that region or country. Please discuss the matter in good faith, avoiding friction and conflict.

3. The Common Standards shall be revised as needed.
